Other taxes such as Council Tax and VAT do not count for this purpose. The charity will reclaim 25p for every £1 that you donate.

If your circumstances change and you no longer pay enough Income Tax or Capital Gains Tax to cover the amount claimed by the charity, you can cancel the declaration at any time by notifying the charity. Please notify the charity if you change your name or address. Please note that if you are a higher rate tax payer you can claim personal tax relief on the difference between basic and higher rates via your Self-Assessment Tax return.
